Statement from Dalia Dippolito spokesman on motion accusing prosecutors of violating judge's orders

(March 30, 2017) - The following is a statement from **Glenn Selig, spokesman for Dalia Dippolito**, on a motion her attorney filed last night asking the judge to bring in "Craig Williams, Assistant State Attorney, and/or Laura Laurie, Assistant State Attorney, and/or Elizabeth Parker, Esq." to explain why they should not be held in "criminal contempt of court for failing to obey a lawfully issued order restricting the dissemination of evidence and facts in this case."
