

Independent, nonpartisan The Profiling Project announces plans to expand investigative team

Earlier this week, the independent, nonpartisan The Profiling Project released its preliminary 80-page report on Seth Rich who was shot to death a year ago next month.

Concluded that the murder was not “random,” contradicting the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD).



ARLINGTON, Virginia – The Profiling Project announced plans today to expand its investigative team that’s independently examining the mysterious murder of DNC staffer Seth Rich.

Earlier this week, the nonpartisan The Profiling Project released its preliminary 80-page report on Rich, who was shot to death a year ago next month.

Volunteer investigators working with the Project, including nearly two dozen graduate students from George Washington University, concluded that the murder was not “random,” contradicting the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD).

The Project, funded by lawyer and GOP lobbyist Jack Burkman, is currently awaiting a court hearing before the Washington, D.C. Superior Court to force the police department to publicly release critical evidence in the Seth Rich investigation.

The Profiling Project is recruiting experienced forensic investigators, including those with leadership skills.

Kevin Doherty, a lead investigator with the Project, informed the Project this morning that he will depart, effectively today.

“This effort is far bigger than any single one of us,” says Burkman. “Sometimes the media attention—whether it be accolades or criticism—can be overwhelming. We wish Kevin all the best and thank him for his tireless efforts to find who killed Seth.”

Jennifer Rohrer, Ph.D., a clinical and forensic psychologist in the District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, and Virginia, who co-launched the Project, has been promoted to Chief Operating Officer (COO).

The team has dedicated office space at an undisclosed location in Arlington. The Profiling Project will continue to be run independently of Burkman, a GOP lobbyist, or his office.

“Seth Rich’s murder is an incredible mystery. I promised the family and the community that I will do everything I can to find those responsible. The search for justice will go on and I am as determined as ever to find answers,” says Burkman. “The Profiling Project is working hard to solve what happened to Seth.”
